A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in the Mayor's office on March 14th, 1949, with all councillors present namely H. L. Schmalz, Adam Velber, and Leo J. Schmalz.

The minutes of the last meeting were read & approved.

Mayor Louis G. Schmalz located a safe in Calgary for \$250.00. The councillors agreed to purchase same if it was large enough to hold all the Village Books, and also if the safe was approved by the Fire Underwriters.

The Secretary was requested to answer the letter with regard to a 1929 Chev. Fire Truck for sale by the Three Hills Town, and find out how much the Town of Three Hills expected for it.

Other correspondence included an application from Dan Gramms for lots 6, 7, and 8 in Block R Plan 8222 FS. The Secretary was requested to answer this letter stating that the Council would have to obtain more information regarding Block R before any further consideration could be given with regard to property required by the Village on these sites.
