

Beiseba, Alberta  
May 9, 1949

A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseba was held in Lewis Garage in the Mayor's office on May 9, 1949, commencing at 9:00 PM with all Councilors present namely Louis Schmalz, Leo Schmalz & Adam Velber. In attendance was Walter Schmalz, a delegate from the Lions Club of Beiseba (Lions Committee of the Club).

The minutes from the last meeting were read and moved by Leo Schmalz that the minutes be adopted as read. Carried.

It was moved by Louis H. Schmalz that the financial statements for April be approved and signed by the Mayor & Secretary. Carried.

Moved by Louis Schmalz that a Building Permit be granted to Apttchek Beneth to erect a dwelling on Part of 13-28-26-04th (50' x 165'). Carried.

Moved by Leo Schmalz that a Building Permit be granted to F. H. Hunt to erect a garage on lot 31 Block 2 Plan 40112. Carried.

A discussion was held with Walter Schmalz, a delegate from the Lions Committee of the Lions Club regarding speedsters within the Village limits. Consequently, it was moved by Louis Schmalz that the Village would co-operate with the Lions Club to curb speeding within the village, by obtaining appropriate sturdy signs for the four entrances into the Village. It was also moved by Louis Schmalz that the Village would stand the cost of these signs, but that the Lions Club would co-operate by erecting these signs. Carried.

It was moved by Louis Schmalz that the Secy write to Mr. Miller with regards to a general assessment to be done sometime this summer, requesting information as to rates, length of time it would require to do a general assessment, & whether Mr. Miller was a member of the Assessment Commission of the Department. Carried.

A discussion regarding sewage disposal for the village was held. It was decided that much more information was required, before the Council could go into detail, or even consider a sewage system for the Village. Louis Schmalz suggested in order to get first hand information regarding this, some members of the Council should interview experienced men of the town or village who had such systems.

The secretary-treasurer reported that the assessment notices had been mailed April 20th, & to date no complaints had been received regarding the notices

The council prepared a preliminary estimate of expenditures in preparation for the mill rate which would be set at a special meeting immediately after the 30 days from mailing the assessment notice last April 20th. This meeting was set for approximately May 20th or 21th.
