The correspondence was read, and it was noted that the Village still had to ex- mark some parcel of land as a public reserve in exchange for Block "R". It was decided to go to Edmonton and see Mr. Holloway personally with regard to this. It was suggested that approximately two acres of the most northern portion of the Andrew Schmalz Estate might be suitable. The Secy-Treasurer was instructed to write to Mr. Holloway for an appointment on Wednesday August 24th, and the Mayor would go on this trip.

The Secy-Treasurer reported that out of the total \$12,318.96 taxes, \$7,589.00 or \$2,761.41 remained unpaid at disbursement date expiring. Out of 84 accounts 73.81% were collected.

It was moved by Louis Schmalz that Tender "8 (a)" be accepted and the work to be carried out at once. Carried.

Tender "8 (b)" was rejected due to the outstanding current taxes at the present time. The Secy Treasurer was instructed to advise Mr. Don Smith, contractor accordingly.
