December 10, 1949.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and moved by Leo Schmatz that they be adopted as read. Carried.

Moved by Leo Schmatz that the financial statement for the month of November be approved, and signed by the mayor and secy-treasurer. Carried.

A bill from Henry Reppmeyer Sr. amounting to \$2.75 for installing four posts on sidewalk leading to the Memorial Hall was tabled until proper authorization of payment could be made. If every thing was in order, payment of this bill was to be made before the end of the year.

It was suggested by the Council that a definite program regarding the collection of garbage had to be worked out in the new year.

Although the Council authorized the payment of a bill to R. McClutcheon amounting to \$127.00 for a subdivision of Block A and other portions of the N.W. 1/4 Section 12, Twp 24, Range 26, W4th M., it felt that the Village should not have to bear this cost of survey. It was decided to interview Mr. Peter Schmatz regarding this - & perhaps collect the cost of this survey from Mr. Schmatz, the Municipal District of Creechill, Mrs. Hilde Bauhman, or from all three, or from any one of them concerned.

It was brought to the attention of the Council that the Star Coffee Bar had made no serious efforts in cleaning up its premises. It was suggested by the Council that the mayor contact Mr. White, our appointed health inspector, & have Mr. White see the prop. of the cafe in question, telling him that its conditions had to be corrected immediately, or be closed up.

The Secy-Treasurer reported that he had written the Holy Cross Hospital with regard their statement for Leo Schefflmaier stating that Mr. Leo Schefflmaier had worked prior to the accident & was again working after his release from hospital. Taking this into consideration, it was felt that the hospital should bill Mr. Schefflmaier directly.

First reading was given to By-law # 87 (A By-law of the Village of Beiseba providing for the donation of a parcel of land to the Beiseba and District Memorial Hall Company) and it was moved by Adam Ulber that first reading of this By-law be passed and approved. Carried.

Second reading was given to By-law #87 and it was moved by
Leo Schmalz that second reading of this By-law be passed & approved. Carried.
Third reading was given to By-law #87 and it was moved by
Leo Schmalz that third reading of this By-law be passed & approved. Carried.

Also, first reading was given to By-law #88 (Enacting the Council
of the Village of Beresford to amend By-law #69) and it was moved by Adam
Delkes that first reading of this By-law be passed & approved. Carried.
Second reading was given to By-law #88 and it was moved by Leo
Schmalz that second reading of this By-law be passed & approved. Carried.
Third reading was given to By-law #88 and it was moved
by Leo Schmalz that third reading of this By-law be passed & approved.
Carried.
