December 31, 1949

A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseles was held in the Mayor's office in Louis Garage on December 31, 1949 commencing at 10:15 with all councillors in attendance namely Mayor L. H. Schmetz, Adam Oelke & Leo J. Schmetz.

The minutes of the last meeting was read to the Council by the Secy. Treasurer and moved by Adam Oelke that the minutes be adopted as read. Carried

Moved by Leo Schmetz that the financial statement for the month of December be approved. Carried

The matter of payment of Henry Desfontaines' bill to the Village for installing four posts on the sidewalks leading to the Memorial Hall was again brought before the Council. It was moved by Leo Schmetz that this bill should be paid. Carried.

The Secy reported that he had interviewed Mr Peter Schmetz with regard to the nuisance made of Block "A" and the bill which the Village paid. The Secy reported that Mr Schmetz felt that he should bear some of the cost, & that the M.D. of Onehill should also bear some. As it was so close to the end of the year, Mr Schmetz decided to look after this matter more deeply in the new year 1950.

The inspector's report by Mrs Madawc was read to the Council. The report was filed, & the Secy-Treasurer was asked to acknowledge the letter.

By resolution of the Council, the application of Mr Wm Jones, proprietor of the Red & White Store located on lot 38, 39, Block 1 Plan 4011X was approved. This was in regard to add new lines of furniture, hardware and sporting goods to his present license.

A letter from the manager, Mr. Ken Wright of the Royal Band Branch in Beiseles was read to the Council. This was in regard to asbestos siding which the Band proposed in using in the construction of their new building next year. The Council still wasn't satisfied that this type of siding was fireproof, & asked the Secy Treasurer to write to Mr. Ken Wright stating this - & also to make an official application for a building license so that we could have this on file.

The Secy-Treasurer was asked to write to the Department of Public Health, Division of Sanitary Engineering, Edmonton, requesting their inspectors to close up the Star Coffee Bar, due to its unsanitary condition.

Moved by Louis H. Schmetz that Mr. C. F. Holube be appointed as our Sanitary Inspector for the year 1950. Carried. The Secy Treasurer was asked to notify the Department of Health concerning this.

The Secy was also asked to get copies of regulations concerning ① Communicable Diseases ② Restaurants ③ Barber ④ Food & Drink ⑤ Nuisances & General Sanitation

nuisances from the Division of Sanitary Engineering, Department of Public Health  
Edmonton.

The Secy-Treasurer was asked to order a copy of the Public Health  
Act from the Kings Printer, Edmonton.

The letter from the Department of Municipal Affairs concerning taxation  
of teachers was tabled for a later date.

It was brought to the attention of the Council that the  
Beverly Hockey Club would not be interested in the Skating Rink for  
the season 1949-50. It was then moved by Louis L. Schmidt that  
Alex Metzger be hired as caretaker for the Skating rink at a salary of  
\$75.00 a month, his duties commencing January 4th, 1950. Carried.  
A set of Rules was drawn up, rates of season tickets set up, and the  
Secy-Treasurer was asked to post these in the Skating Rink House.

The Council was pleased in the collection of taxes.

The Secy-Treasurer was asked to write to Mr. Katterhagen  
Rockyford to have our books audited, just as soon as the Secy-Treasurer  
could get the books ready for him.

Moved by Louis L. Schmidt that the meeting do now adjourn  
Time 12:00 Noon. Carried
