The Secy-Treasurer was instructed to write to Mr. Matt Schmalz and Mr. Peter Schmalz in regard to the survey made last summer on Block "A" and part of the N.W. 1/4 Section 12-29-28, Q26, West 4th Meridian. The Council feels that the Village should not bear the cost of this survey.
