Results of Councillor Election

I attended at the south room of the Beiseker Skating Rink House, at Beiseker, Alberta, for the purpose of presiding over the election of councillor for the Village of Beiseker on Monday February 27th, 1950.

At 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon I declared the poll open, unlocked, examined, and locked the ballot box, appointed George H. Schmalz as poll clerk, and proceeded with the election.

At 7:00 o'clock in the afternoon I declared the poll as closed, unlocked the ballot box in the presence of the authorized agents, poll clerk and Mayor H. H. Schmalz, and proceeded with the counting of the ballots. The results were as follows:

- Harris H. Schmalz - One Hundred and Five (105) Votes
- Alic Goodman - Forty-eight (48) Votes
- Spoiled Ballots - None

I declared Harris H. Schmalz as duly elected for the years 1950 and 1952, and I declared the results publicly on Tuesday, the 28th day of February, 1950, at ten o'clock in the forenoon.
