



Beiseba, Alberta
March 6th, 1950

A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseba was held in Louis Garage on Monday, March 6th, 1950 commencing at 9:00 P.M. with all councillors in attendance namely L. H. Schmalz, Leo Schmalz and Adam Velkes. In attendance also were J. H. Schmalz, Val Schmalz, W. J. Harris, Matt Schmalz and Carl E. Schmalz representing the Board of Trade, Louis Club, the local school board and the district school trustee.

Before the Council touched regular Village business, a discussion was held with Mr. J. H. Schmalz, school trustee in the chair concerning mainly with the building of a new school in Beiseba, & the need for a higher school requisition. He told the gathering that there was a greater need for a eight or ten room school instead of the proposed 6-room school to which all groups represented unanimously agreed. He also stated that in the near future we would have another mayoral election and he hoped that he would have the support of the new Council, the Board of Trade, the Louis Club & the local school board.

The Returning Officer, Peter Dimes, declared the result of the Village election held February 27th in the snack room of the Beiseba Skating Rink House.

That Louis H. Schmalz was elected councillor and that Alex Goodman was defeated. Louis H. Schmalz received 105 votes and Alex Goodman received 48 votes with no ballots spoiled. The newly elected councillor, L. H. Schmalz was to remain in office until February, 1953.

Louis H. Schmalz signed the declaration of office for councillor.

Moved by Leo J. Schmalz and seconded by Adam Velkes that Louis H. Schmalz be Mayor for the Village of Beiseba for the year 1950. Carried.

Moved by Adam Velkes that the minutes of the previous meeting be adopted and read. Carried.

Moved by Leo Schmalz that the financial statement for the month of February be adopted, & to be signed by the Secy and Mayor. Carried.

The Council agreed to continue the service of Peter Dimes as Secretary - Treasurer for the year 1950. This was moved by Adam Velho and Carried. It was moved by Louis H. Schmalz to pay an annual salary of \$ 350.00 to the Secretary - Treasurer which could be drawn quarterly. Carried.

Moved by Leo Schmalz that G. M. Katterhagen of New Norway, Alberta be appointed Auditor for the year 1950 at a salary of \$ 25.00. Carried. The Secy - Treasurer was to advise Mrs Katterhagen of the Department of the appointment.

As a resolution was passed by the Council at a former meeting to have an Assessor appointed by the Director of Assessments, Edmonton, to do a general assessment of real property within the Village for the year 1950, no appointment of an Assessor was necessary.

Moved by Leo Schmalz that Matt Schmalz, Beiseker, be appointed Supervisor of Public Works and Commissioner of Buildings within the Village for the year 1950. Carried. The Secy - Treasurer was instructed to advise Mr Matt Schmalz of the appointment.

Moved by Louis Schmalz that R. J. Holube, Beiseker, be appointed Inspector for Child Welfare for the Village for the year 1950. Carried. The Secy - Treasurer was instructed to advise the Department of Mr Holube of the appointment.

A Sanitary Inspector for the Village was appointed at a former meeting.

Correspondence:

The Calgary Power advised the Council in a letter dated February 27th, that they had located Mr. A. C. Troyde, as District Manager in the Village of Beiseker. The Secy - Treasurer was instructed to convey the Council's appreciation of this appointment in a letter to the Calgary Power.

A letter from the Holy Cross Hospital, Calgary, dated February 15th with regard to Mr. Leo Scheffelmair's account was read to the Council. As the Hospital requested payment from the Village for this unpaid account, the Council decided to interview Mr. Scheffelmair at a Council meeting. The Council set Saturday morning at 10:00 AM, March 11th in the office of the Mayor, Louis Garay, as the time and place. The Secy - Treasurer was instructed to advise Leo Scheffelmair of this interview by registered mail.

Mayor G. H. Schmalz advised the Council that Mrs Edith Walker was seeking assistance in the way of a Mother's Allowance. Although Mrs Walker had filed in an application

additional signatures on the application were necessary. The Mayor told the Council that he would request Mrs Walker to fill in the necessary blanks, & at a latter Council meeting, her application would again be brought before the Council for recommendation. The Secy-Treasurer was instructed to write to the Department for a list or a scale of money paid to needy mothers & dependents.

The Council decided to close the Skating Rink for this year as the ice was melted by the warm weather. Louis P. Schmatz was to advise the rink caretaker Alex Metzger to take down the lights and shades, store them in the Skating Rink House and lock the Rink House.

With regard to the survey made on Block A last summer & the costs thereof paid by the Village, the Secy-Treasurer reported that Mrs Peter Schmatz & Miss Baummaier had decided to attend at a meeting of the Municipal District of Kneehill at Three-Hills, before re-imbursing the Village.

It was decided to table the results of the General Assessment recently received from the Department until Saturday morning for discussion.

Moved by Adam Velber that the meeting do now adjourn
