Mr. Schmaltz was advised to arrange to have someone grade Fifth Street, Second Avenue and from the Bank Corner to the S. M. R. Station and also the North end of First Avenue and the road from First Avenue to the S. P. R. railroad.

Mr. Schmaltz was also authorized to have someone go over the Village property and pull all noxious weeds that was growing on land that was not held by lease or otherwise by persons known to us.
