A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseba was held in Louis Garage on Monday, March 12th commencing at 8:20 P.M. with the following Councillors in attendance namely H. L. Schmalz and Adam Velber. Leo Schmalz was absent due to illness.

The Returning Officer, Peter Deines declared that only one nomination was received - that of Leo J. Schmalz, & therefore no election was necessary. Leo J. Schmalz was declared elected as councillor by acclamation for the years 1951, '52 and '53. As Leo J. Schmalz was absent from the meeting, the Secretary Treasurer was to see him in order to sign the declaration of office for Councillor.

The Secretary explained to the Councillors that due to the stormy & inclement weather, it was impossible to hold our first meeting on the Monday of March 5th. It was therefore postponed to the regular meeting night, on March 12th.

Moved by Adam Velber that Louis L. Schmalz be Mayor for the Village of Beiseba for the year 1951. Carried.

Moved by Adam Velber that the minutes of the previous meeting be adopted as read. Carried.

Moved by Adam Velber that the financial statement for the months of January & February be adopted, & to be signed by the Mayor & Secy-Treasurer. Carried.

The following bills were okayed for payment as indicated by signature thereon: Day Schmalz repairs to motor \$11.70; Memorial Hall rent for annual meeting \$5.00; National Grain Co coal for skating rink \$~~8.30~~ \$8.30; & Wheatland School Division 1st quarterly school requisition \$2001.06.

A letter dated January 31st from the Canadian Cancer Society which listed the many social service assistances which the Society offered to cancer patients was read to the Council & tabled.

The Council briefly reviewed the 1951 budget statement from the Wheatland School Dist. The Auditor's Financial Statement from the Wheatland School Division was discussed. It was noted that our school requisition for the year 1951 had risen from \$7578.14 to \$8004.23 an increase of \$426.09 over last year.

A request for a money grant from the Salvation Army was read and tabled.

A letter dated March 1st, 1951 from the Office of Medical Officer of Health, Rural Health Unit, Widdoway, Alta in connection with Rural Health Units was read to the Council. Since the Village of Beiside was at the present time being served by the one nurse Health Unit from the Wheatland School District, the Council felt that it did not want to join the Widdoway Health Unit at the present time. The Secy-Treasurer was asked to advise them accordingly.

A letter from the Drumheller Municipal Hospital District #3 addressed to the former Mayor Fa'haunt was read to the Council by the Secy. The Board wished to know, since the Village did not belong to any organized hospital district, whether they were interested in joining the Drumheller Municipal Hospital District. The Council asked the Secy to inform the Hospital Board, that we were at the present time studying the Municipal Hospital Act, & were not, at the present time, able to tell them if or what Municipal District we would join.

An application for Building Permit dated August 22, 1950 from the Wheatland School Division re: two teacherages was presented to the Council. Moved by Adam Velba that a Building Permit upon payment of \$1.00 be granted to the Wheatland School to construct the teacherages on the sites as mentioned in the application. Carried.

The Secy advised the Council that the survey & plans in the area now known as Block W, Block V and Block R2 was now

registered & the plan number was "Beside 1816.GG." The Secy was also pleased to inform the Council that all the transfers in that area were now almost all completed.

The Secy informed the Council that in accordance with sections 483 and 484 of the Regulations Respecting Dairy Farms, the Secy-Treasurer on behalf of the Village of Beside & our local Health Board, presented Mr. Walter Schmalz who operates a Milk Producer - Distributor establishment with a Certificate of Registration. This certificate became effective January 1st, 1951 & is valid until December 31st, 1951.

Although the Holy Cross Hospital threatened legal action unless the Village paid Mr. Leo Scheffelmair's hospital account, the Council still felt that same as they did in the past. The Council informed the Secy to advise the Hospital accordingly, & disclaimed any responsibility absolutely.

Since time was limited the delegate's report who were Peter Deins & Louis H. Schmalz, on the Civil Defense meeting held at Red Deer, Alta, Wednesday, January 24th at 2:00 P.M. in the Buffalo Hotel was postponed until a later date.

Moved by Louis H. Schmalz that Peter Deins continue his term as Secy-Treasurer for the year 1951. Moved by Louis H. Schmalz to pay Peter Deins an annual salary of \$400.00 which could be drawn quarterly. Carried.

Moved by Adam Velber that E. B. Allan, 129A-7th Ave West, Calgary, Alberta be appointed Auditor for the year 1951 at a salary of \$25.00 to \$50.00. The Secy-Treasurer was to advise Mr. Allan & the Department of the appointment.

Moved by Louis H. Schmalz that Stan Torrance, Carbon, Alberta be appointed Assessor for the current year at a salary to be fixed later. The Mayor was to advise the Department of the appointment & the Secy was asked to inform Mr. Torrance.

Moved by Adam Velber that Matt Schmalz Beside be appointed Supervisor of Public Works & Commissioner of Buildings within the Village for the year 1951. Carried. The Secy. was instructed to advise Mr. Schmalz accordingly.

Moved by Louis H. Schmalz that C. J. Rohrer Beside be appointed Inspector for Child Welfare for the Village of Beside for the year 1951. Carried. The Secy-Treasurer was instructed to advise the Department & Mr. Rohrer of the appointment.

A Sanitary Inspector for the Village was appointed at a former meeting.

Moved by Adam Velber that W. J. Gavigan, Beside be appointed

Inspector for the Presence of Rats for the Village of Bessemer for the year 1951. Carried.  
The Deey was instructed to advise the Department & Mr. Lennie.

The Deey-Treasurer advised the Council that Mr. Felix Silberman of Tudos, Alta had not paid the taxes on his property for the past two years. The Deey was instructed to file a tax caveat against the property - lots 20021, Block 1 Plan 4011X.

Moved by Adam Velder that the meeting do now adjourn  
Time 10:00 Carried.
