Regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in the Mayor's office in Louis Garage on Monday, June 11th commencing at 8:00 P.M. with all councillors in attendance namely L. D. Schmalz, Adam Velke, and Leo J. Schmalz.

Moved by Adam Velke that the minutes from the last meeting be adopted as read. Carried.

The issuing of the following cheques was confirmed:—

As the Village of Beiseker inadvertently omitted to comply with Section 18, subsection 2 of the Assessment Act, which would have authorized our Council to adopt by resolution, if passed prior to the first day of April, the assessment of land including buildings & improvements of 1950 as the assessment for the current year. Inspector Paul Lloyd (Assessment Inspector), who visited the Secy-Treasurer's office June 2nd, advised the Council of the Village of Beiseker to apply to the Minister of Municipal Affairs for an extension of time for the passing of this resolution. This extension of time was granted until June 30th, 1951 in a Ministerial Order dated June 7th.

Moved by Mayor L. D. Schmalz that the assessment for the current year remain the same as that of the previous year. Carried.

Therefore be it resolved that the assessment of land including buildings & improvements made in 1950 be adopted as the assessment for the current year.

The Secy was asked to forward a copy of this resolution to the Director of Assessment forthwith.
