October 27, 1951.

A meeting of the Council of The Village of Beiseker was held in the mayor's office in Louis's Garage on Saturday, October 27, commencing at 11:25 A.M. Councillors L. L. Schmaltz, Adam Velker and Leo Schmaltz were in attendance.

Moved by Adam Velker that the minutes from the last meeting be adopted as read. Carried.

Moved by Leo Schmaltz that the financial statement for the month of September be adopted. The Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer signed the statement. Carried.

The issuing of the following cheques was confirmed:

The following bills and statements were authorized for payment: Steve Silbernogel = 48.50, Saskatoon Fire Engine Co. = 59.29, Kneehill Municipality = 10.00, Beiseker Motors = 13.26, Crown Lumber = 409.15, Municipal Supplies = 6.27, Provincial Treasurer - M1556 = 10.00, and Wheatland School Division = 2001.06, as indicated by the councillors signatures thereon.

Approval of a building permit for Imperial Oil Co. was refused because the description of the site was incorrect. The Sec. Treas. was advised to return the permit for the necessary corrections.

After a discussion it was decided that the Village hire Raymond Schmaltz to erect the tower for our fire siren and also hire Carl Chandler to erect our prefabricated fire hall. Councillor L. L. Schmaltz stated he would see these men as soon as possible.

Moved by Leo Schmaltz that Horne Bunyan be appointed enumerator for the Supplementary Voters' List. Carried.

Due to the large number of current taxes as yet not paid the Council advised the Sec. Treasurer to write reminders to the rate-

payers concerned.

The Council was advised by L. L. Schmalty that he had authorized Steve Silbermagel to cut the weeds in the skating rink before the cold weather.

The Sec. Treasurer was advised to inform himself about the Calgary District Hospital Plow and the necessary formalities to put it into action and to report to the next meeting.

The Sec. Treasurer read a letter from Horace Loudew dated Oct. 22 in which he refuses to pay our claim for damages of six dollars. The Sec. Treasurer was then advised to do more research on the matter and to again contact Mr. Loudew with regard to the damages.

The Council discussed the possibility of having a gallow of our "Fire Death" analyzed in Calgary. Leo Schmalty stated that he would do so at an early date.

Leo Schmalty reminded the Council that the Villoge owns some sacks of cement stored in the garage on the residential property owned by Peter Schmalty. He suggested that the council see that the cement is fully protected against the elements. It was agreed that this be done.

Moved by L. L. Schmalty that we do now adjourn. Time - 12.35 P.M.
