A meeting of the Councils of the Villages of Beiseker and Irricana was held in the home of the Mayor of Irricana on Friday, Nov. 30, commencing at 8:25 P.M., for the purpose of organizing Civil - Defence. Those present were:

Mrs. Eline Byres - the joint Beiseker-Irricana Civil Defence instructor.

Mr. H. Long, Mr. L.L.Schmaltz, Mr. Leo Schmaltz, Mr. Adam Velker, Mr. J. Steele, Mr. A.L. Patterson and Mr. Bell (Sec. Treas. for The Village of Irricana). Acting Secretary - Mr.L.W.Bunyan.

Mayor H. Long, Chairman for the meeting, opened by asking Mrs. Byres to suggest an order of business due to the fact that she had graduated from the Old's Civil Defence School for Instructors.

Mrs. Byers advised the meeting to appoint a Controller or Controllers to supervise the organization. Mayor L.L.Schmaltz of Beiseker moved that Mrs. Eline Byres be appointed Chief-Controller for Beiseker and Irricana and that a Deputy*Controller be appointed in each of the above Villages by the respective Councils. The motion was seconded by Mr. J.Steele. CARRIED


The respective councils then took up the problem of appointing Deputy-Controllers. The Village of Irricana appointed Mr. Bell, Secretary-Treasurer of the said Village, to represent them. The Village of Beiseker appointed Mr. L.W.Bunyan, Secretary-Treasurer of the said village, to represent them.

It was then agreed that the above appointments shall be called the Control-Committee.

After some discussion the Meeting agreed that the Controller should give a course on controlling to persons from each of the Villages. The number of persons from each Village is to be SIX if possible and functional if possible. (e.g. Fire--- The Fire-Chiefs)

The Secretary for the meeting was advised to inform the authorities of these appointments.

Moved by Adam Velker that we do now adjourn, Time- 9:15 P.M. and Seconded by A.L.Patterson. CARRIED

It was agreed that the Council investigate the problem of having the skating-rink flooded and Councillor Leo promised to see the foreman at the new school with regard to using the well in that building.

The Sec.-Treas. informed the council that he had received no answer to his last letter to Horace Loudon who was billed for damages to Village street lights (decorative). The Council agreed to let the matter drop because of the already lengthy correspondence and the small nature of the bill (\$6.00).

After a short discussion about the Village's new fire-siren tower which was damaged while being set up, Councillor Adam said that he would contact Raymond Schmaltz with regard to the needed repairs.

Mayor Louis suggested that Dr. Thompson of the Drumheller Health Unit be invited to Beiseker to address a gathering, in order that the Unit might be introduced and explained, sometime after the New Year.

Adam Velker was authorized by the Council to have 12 keys made for the new fire-hall in order that they could be spread about the Village in strategic places.

Moved by Councillor Leo that we do now adjourn.
