A meeting of the Council of The Village of Beiseker was held in the Mayor's office in Louis' Garage on Thursday, Dec. 6, commencing at 4:30 P.M. Councillors L.L.Schmaltz, Adam Velker and Leo Schmaltz were in attendance.

Moved by Adam Velker that the minutes from the last meeting be adopted as read. Carried

Moved by Leo Schmaltz that the financial-statements for the months of October and November be adopted. The Mayor and the Secretary-Treasurer signed the statements. Carried

The following bills and statements were authorized for payment: Provincial Treasurer-10.00, F.B.Matthews-3.96, Linden Transport-8.57, Calgary Power- 90.00, Carl Lohrke-5.00, King's Printer 1.90, Felix Hagel and Sons- 169, Crown Lumber- 22.81, Sundre Contracting- 465.75, J.E.Keim-10.00, Ted Bechtold- 10.00, Henry Reifsnnyder- 15.00, Earl Chandler Jr.-180.00, Adam Velker- 4.35, Provincial Treasurer-10.00, and Quarterly Requisition- 2001.05, as indicated by the councillors signatures thereon.

Three building permits were received and passed by the council for the following: William Ternes ( Garage), United Grain Growers (Annex), Imperial Oil Ltd. ( Bulk station on C.N.R.). A \$1.00 fee was received for each permit.

The Secretary-Treasurer advised the council that he had notified Mrs. Edith Walker of the seizure of the rental that she pays to ratepayer Felix Silbernagel. Because Mrs. Walker had not as yet paid any of the rental the council authorized the Sec. Treas. to see Mrs. Walker and try to resolve the whole matter.

A letter was read from the Calgary Rural Hospital Dist. No. 63 asking the council whether they were considering joining the Plan before the first of 1952. After some discussion the council authorized the Sec.-Treas. to make application for entry into the District and ask for a date on which the council might meet the Board of said District.

Because there were some taxes as yet unpaid the Council advised the Sec. Treas. to notify the ratepayers concerned that the books had to be closed at the end of the year and that payment of said taxes would be appreciated.


