
Moved by Leo Schmaltz that the first reading of By-Law No.97 be passed and approved. Carried

Moved by Adam Velker that the second reading of By-Law No.97 be passed and approved. Carried


Moved by L.L.Schmaltz that the third reading of By-Law No.97 be passed and approved. Carried
