
The Drumheller Health Unit, Quarterly Statement, was produced and examined by the councillors.

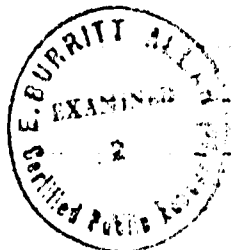


