With regard to the F.J.Pratt Construction Bill for \$352.80; the Wheatland School Division will pay the Village \$152.80. The Mayor gave this information and directed the Secretary to bill the School Div. accordingly.

The Mayor also informed the Council that Carl Lohrke has agreed to ring the fire alarm every day at noon if a switch is installed in the Post Office, his place of business; also, that Carl L.Schmaltz has been directed to install the said switch and also place a glassed-in switch on the fire hall.

The Secretary read a letter from Poole Construction stating that they had made an error in charging \$10.00 an hour for use of their machinery that was hired by the Village for use on the streets and that they wished to change that figure to \$9.00.

Mr. Vickerman from the Engineering firm of Haddin, Davis and Brown was introduced to the Council and he was asked to give a detailed account of how sewage and water could be got for the Village. Mr. Vickerman gave a very clear account of methods and problems and was then asked many questions by the Council which he answered. He told the Council that if they made a formal request for a Sewage and Water Report that his firm would survey the Village and show what can be done, investigate wells, make plans of the town and estimate costs to put in sewage and water and costs to operate the sewage disposal.


The Secretary was asked to send out a letter to that effect immediately.


