Moved by C. F. Weisgerber and seconded by G. W. Buehring that F. A. Fount act as Reeve for the ensuing year;

The following business was transacted;

Moved by C. F. Weisgerber and seconded by G. W. Buehring that no one is allowed to play Ball and use any building in the Village as a back stop, any one doing so shall be liable for damages incurred and a fine not exceeding ten dollars and costs;

Moved by F. A. Fount seconded by C. F. Weisgerber that the Secretary Treasurer Report be adopted as read for the year 1921;

Moved by F. A. Fount seconded by G. W. Buehring and C. F. Weisgerber that John J. Gorty be act as Secretary & Treasurer for year 1922; at a salary one hundred dollars;

Moved by C. F. Weisgerber seconded by G. W. Buehring that Norman Schertzberg be the official dog catcher for the year 1922 with authority to kill and destroy any dogs found within Village limits for period longer than twenty four hours without a tag and without an owner and of which there is sufficient proof that the dog is a stray and a tramp dog.

Schertzberg has authority to charge the Council with the shells used in discharge of his duty;
