Motion by Mayor L.ouis that Alex Metzger be taken off of the arrears list. Carried.


A considerable discussion was held over the subject of a well test for the Water and Sewage program. It was agreed that the Council meet with the engineers in the very near future to clarify such things as "Who pays for the well test". It was decided to include Matt Hagel's and Alex Uffelman's wells in the list mentioned in the previous minutes. It was also agreed that T. Beggerie could be contacted with regard to testing and consulting. (T. Beggerie-Well-Driller)

A discussion also arose out of the Skating Rink problem. It was agreed that Otto Metz be contacted with regard to flooding. The cost would be discussed later.

It was brought to the attention of the Council that a Mr. Raffa would like to purchase three lots on which to build a 2 car garage and a modern home. The suitability of a site was thoroughly discussed. It was suggested that property owned by Mr. Gottlieb Berreth (I-12-II92FR) and Mr. Lawrence Fisher (50-L-227) would be suitable and that these men should be approached in this regard.
