Regarding the Maintenance of Village Lines on Ratepayer's Property West of the C.P.R. Right-of-way:

Attention By Mayor Schmaltz that the Village will supply the necessary clean outs and regular maintenance other than earth work on the water and sewage lines after the trenches are covered. This is in regard to Lots 1-5 Block I, Plan 703GE. This shall all be done to a point 30 feet from the houses now thereon and this agreement shall be subject to any future agreements.




