The council considered the subject of 1954 mill rates for the last time and agreed on the following.

School.....29.00
Municipal..13.5
Total.....46.00 mills

Joe J. Hagel, Beiseker Fire Chief, was present and after some discussion it was agreed that Fire Chief Hagel and his Deputy, G. Reddikopp, should attend the Civil Defence Fire Instructors school to be held in Calgary, May 10-15, at a salary of \$5.00 per day per man.

The Secretary was authorized to contact Mr. McCutcheon, Dominion surveyor, with a view to having him survey Mr. Lawrence Fisher's property into lots, Streets, and alleys are also to be surveyed surrounding this whole area.

Motion by Councillor Lavoie that the Expropriation By-Law III be amended to show less the road allowances within the said expropriation, and that it receive first reading as amended.

Moved by Councillor Lavoie that it receive Second reading:


