The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and agree on the procedure that the Village Plumbing Inspectors would take.

Parkdale Plumbing produced a letter showing that inspections can be flexible.

The Council agreed that due to the circumstances the plumbing inspectors would be asked to make only SPOT tests with regard to the pressure test.

The firms represented promised to give the Council a letter of guarantee on their work in the village for one year.

The service time for inspections was set at an 8 hour limit from the time of request.

With regard to OLD plumbing the inspectors and plumbers are to follow the Act in all cases that they are affected directly.


Allan Skuce was also appointed as plumbing inspector for the village to assist Lorne Bunyan.
