Minutes The Minutes for the eighth day of November were read by the Secretary-Treasurer upon motion of Councillor Lavoie were adopted as read. The Mayor and the Secretary-Treasurer then signed these minutes.

Mrs. Edith Walker: After some discussion and finally acting on the advise of the Municipal Inspectors the council advised the secretary to return the file to Three Hills with a letter to the effect that the village does not feel responsible for the woman after her absence for so many years.

Feed Mill The Secretary was advised to make another attempt to get a building permit from the owners of the feed mill recently built, and if one is not forthcoming to advise the said owners of the act regarding such matters.

Gottlieb Berreth: The Council discussed the proposed moving of a building onto main street by Mr. Berreth and noted that he had not done anything in that regard as yet.

Inspectors As per the inspectors advise the village had engaged their auditor to go over the books with the secretary. It was noted by the council that the auditor had found nothing out of the ordinary with regard to the keeping of the books.

By-Law II A by-law regarding exemption of church property from frontage for water and sewage was presented and upon motion by Councillor Lavoie was given first reading:

The secretary presented the complaints in the following order with the noted decisions:

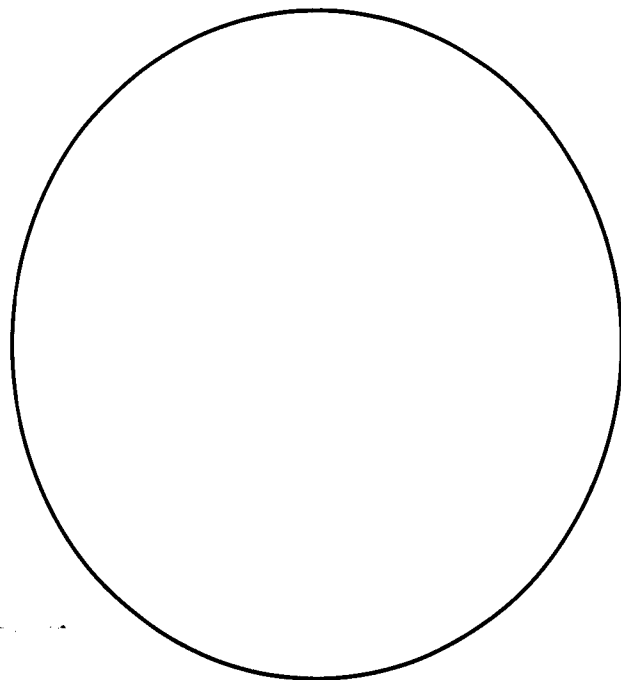
- I. C.P.R. Reject easement of frontage.
