A meeting of the Village Council was held in F. A. Fount's office on January 23<sup>rd</sup> 1922, and the following business was transacted;

The minutes of the previous meeting was adopted as read;

Moved by C. F. Weisgerber seconded by F. A. Fount that Norman Schertzberg act as Village Police for the year 1922 and that it will be his duty to enforce all By-laws, and also to bring before the Council anything that he deems necessary for their consideration; he is also expected to enforce all Rules enacted by the Department of Health; In case of a conviction where a fine is implied he shall receive one half of the fine, and the Village the other half.

It shall further be the ~~of the~~ <sup>authority</sup> Police to take full charge and authority in connection with any and all Fire Apparatus and to inspect all Buildings, stoves, Pipes, and see that same is to be safe also to clean up all fire traps, such as Rubbish etc; And to control and Regulate all Bond Fires;

Moved by C. F. Weisgerber seconded by G. W. Buehring it is hereby enacted that the speed limit for automobiles be not greater than fifteen miles per hour within the Village limits; the Penalty to be Five Dollars and Costs and any Damages;

Moved by C. F. Weisgerber seconded by G. W. Buehring that Dr. W. G. Fowler be the official Health Inspector of the Village of Peiseker.
