A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Bunker was held in J. A. Lounis's office, and notice of meeting is hereby waived. All councilors present:

Minutes of the Previous Meeting read and adopted.

The Early Closing By-Law came up for discussion and it was unanimously decided to amend same to read as follows:-

That all places of business, except grays, pool rooms, restaurants, hotels and drug stores, be closed at 6 p.m., with the exception of from August 15<sup>th</sup> to November 15<sup>th</sup> and from December 15<sup>th</sup> to December 24<sup>th</sup>, inclusive, also all days before public holidays and Saturdays.

Restaurants and confectionery stores, carrying a line of groceries, shall be considered a place of business according to this Act, and shall comply with this Act by pulling a curtain across such line of groceries at the said hour of closing such places of business.

Implement dealers are allowed open from April 15<sup>th</sup> to June 1<sup>st</sup> and from August 1<sup>st</sup> to November 15<sup>th</sup> and from December 15<sup>th</sup> to December 24<sup>th</sup>, inclusive, and shall be closed at 6 p.m. all the rest of the year, with the exception of all days before public holidays and Saturdays.

Elevators are open in compliance with this Act and also during threshing season.


