

Beisekw.
Aug. 13, 1928.

a special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beisekw was held in P. O. Lounsb's office and notice of meeting is hereby waived. All councilmen present.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and adopted.

The council authorized the building of sidewalks as follows:-

- (1) an 8' sidewalk on the North side of Sixth Street with cement buttman 8" x 8" x 8' and where required same to be increased to proper size; same to be placed eight feet apart and iron anchor pins for the outside and inside stringer
- (2) Sidewalk to the school. This sidewalk to be built as far as possible from the old lumber taken from the sidewalk on Main Street.
- (3) A sidewalk on North side of Fifth Street also sidewalk on South side of Fifth Street from west end to community Hall to be built of 2-12" boards running lengthwise and properly supported and pinned.
- (4) Sidewalk on the South side of Sixth Street to consist of three planks running lengthwise and properly supported and pinned
- (5) Sidewalk between Sixth and Seventh Street on Second Avenue (West side) to be constructed properly and to consist of 2 planks running lengthwise.
- (6) Crossing between north and south side of Sixth Street and in the centre of the Block to be built of cement.

The new material necessary for such walks amounts to 1400 feet and to be purchased from the Crown Lumber Company for \$575.⁵³

All alley crossings to be two planks on top and one plank on each side running lengthwise. The same to apply in front of Velker's blackening shop.

The culvert on the road to Q. N. R. station to be rebuilt and Mr. Schmaltz to supervise work.

The drayman was authorized to fill hole in road south of elevators.

The Secretary-Treasurer was authorized to borrow money to defray sidewalk expenses.

J. Mix was authorized to get stock on lumber unloaded from car.

S. F. Lohke was engaged as foreman on sidewalks at a salary of \$5.00 per day. Work to begin when operations of sidewalks start.

The following bills were authorized to be paid:-

Dr. Fowler \$25.00 Medical Services.
(Mrs Weiss)

Secretary was authorized to pay all labor bills on sidewalk when claims were properly made out and O.K. by Mr. Lohke.

Moved that the meeting adjourn.

Done and passed in Council assembled this 13th day of August, 1928.
