The following bills were authorized to be paid:

Mr. Schmaltz was authorized to repair culvert in street to S. N. R. but it was found necessary to rebuild culvert and same is finished and is hereby authorized.

Mr. Schmaltz was also authorized to have the ditch opened up leading from this culvert through to the S. N. R. railway bridge. The cost to be nine dollars (\$9'00) and payment of same is hereby authorized.

The rink came under discussion and it was decided to lengthen the rink 10 ft. and also widen it 10 ft. for accomodation of the Hockey Club at the request of Hockey Club.

The hours for hockey practice for senior boys were arranged as follows: Tuesday and Thursday nights from 9 to 10 o'clock p. m. Sunday 11 to 12 o'clock p. m. All hockey players must purchase season tickets.

Henry Schmidt was engaged as caretaker of rink at \$30'00 per month. Duties to commence at Noon Nov. 10th /28.

The Council decided they would buy a pump engine and pump jack.

Application for license for draying
was considered and the Council
decided to accept such application.
