A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F. A. Lount's office and notice of same is hereby waived. All councillors present.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and adopted.

Some time ago S. P. Schmaltz, Peter Schmaltz, John Nist and N. Gordon met the Council asking that the Council pay them for the sidewalks that they had built, in so much, that the Village was putting in sidewalks and their sidewalks were acceptable to the Village at the present time. This matter came to the attention again at this meeting and after a thorough discussion Tony Schmaltz, Peter Schmaltz and John Nist was called in and it was unanimously agreed that owing to the fact that the sidewalk in front of the Smolensky property, and represented by N. Gordon, was built prior to the incorporation of the Village of Beiseker and that Mrs. Smolensky had not put any money into this sidewalk but rather that Mr. Holstein, who built it, donated it to the Village of Beiseker the same as all other sidewalks were donated at that time, that N. Gordon had no claim at the present time for such sidewalk.

The other sidewalks were altogether

different in so much that they were
just recently built and the Council
had been interviewed before they were
built, therefore the Council and
Sany Schmalz, Peter Schmalz & John Hirt
^{mutually, agreed as follows:-}
that Sany Schmalz received for
50 feet of No. 1. ^{Portland} sidewalk ~~received~~ \$1.25
per lineal foot. That Peter Schmalz
received \$1.25 for 34 feet of No. 1. ^{Portland} sidewalk
and Peter Schmalz also receive 62 1/2¢
per lineal foot for 16 feet of inferior
cement sidewalk and that John Hirt
receive 62 1/2¢ per lineal foot for 16 feet of
inferior cement sidewalk.

These sidewalks in question are
the sidewalks opposite their
respective place of business.
