

THE MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE  
VILLAGE OF BEISEKER, HELD ON MONDAY THE 13th DAY OF MAY, 1963,  
IN THE VILLAGE OFFICE AT 8P.M.

Minutes: The Sec-Treas. read the minutes of a regular meeting of the Council held on April 8, 1963.  
These minutes were adopted as read on a motion by Councillor Felix Schmaltz.

Cash statement: The Sec-Treas. read cash statements for the months of Jan. and February 1963.  
Councillor Velker moved that these statements be accepted subject to the year end audit.

Out of Minutes: Mayor Schmaltz reporting on the flouridation signs to be erected by the Village, stated that the signs had been ordered and should be on hand soon.

The Council further discussed the matter of water and sewage service requested by the K.I.B.A. Seed Cleaning Plant. Council agreed that all though this service was feasible from an engineering standpoint it would be very costly to build. The Sec-Treas. was instructed to write the firm giving this information and asking if their officials would like further discussions on the matter.

Mayor Schmaltz next reported that the Council had visited the Village of Carstairs to inspect their new Municipal Bldg. and in connection with this it was also stated that a tentative plan for a building was being prepared by a Building firm for Council consideration.

New business: The Mayor reported that Miss Diane Schmaltz of the Village had made application to the Prov. Licensing Branch for a Beauty Parlour operators license and that she wished to open this business in the old Matt Hagel grocery store. Council discussed this matter and finally instructed the Sec-Treas. to write a letter stating that this business would not infringe any local By-Laws.

On the matter of the revision of the By-Law register which had been suggested by the Dept. of Municipal Affairs, the Council instructed the Sec-Treas. to write E.C. Collier, to see if he would be in a position to undertake this work.

Councillor Felix Schmaltz brought up the matter of sale of water during summer months when more water is needed for lawns and gardens. Councillor Schmaltz stated that some other centres give extra water without extra charge for this purpose. After some discussion Councillor Felix Schmaltz moved that the Council give 1000 gals. of water free for each of the months of June, July and August to each customer on the water system.

CARRIED

The Sec-Treas. was instructed to have a notice to this effect printed and mailed to all water users as soon as possible.

Correspondence: Correspondence from the following was read and disposed of as follows:  
I. From Mr. F.G. Braithwaite of Calgary stating that the Alta. Dental Ass. would handle advertising of the flouridation signs when they were put up by the Village, if so desired.
