

THE MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF BEISEKER, HELD ON WEDNESDAY THE 29th DAY OF
MAY 1963, in the VILLAGE OFFICE AT 8 P.M.

Council first discussed the matter of complaints which had been made to all members of the Council by various people regarding the operation of the Crown Lumber Co. store under the present manager. Complaints centered mostly on the store being closed during business hours and general poor business operation. Several reports stated that business was being taken elsewhere. Council agreed that this situation should be reported and the Sec-Treas. was instructed to write the Crown Lumber Co. head office in Calgary advising them of the situation.

Budget:

Council next discussed the matter of the estimates for the year 1963. Calculations were based on a live assessment figure of 614,995. Requisitions on hand indicated total school requisitions of \$15,742 and Council set the mill rate for school purposes at 26 mills. Total Hospital Act and health Unit requisitions amounted to \$2175:00 and Council set the mill rate for Hospital purposes at 4 mills.

Council next estimated total expenditures for municipal purposes at \$11,070:00 and set the mill rate for municipal purposes at 18 mills.

By-Law I52

A By-Law setting out the various mill rates to a total of 48 mills and authorizing the Sec-Treas. to collect property taxes from all rate payers on the tax roll was presented to Council.

Councillor Adam Velker moved it be given first reading.

Councillor Felix Schmaltz moved it be given second reading.


