

THE MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
BEISEKER, SITTING AS A COURT OF REVISION, HELD ON THURSDAY  
THE FIFTH DAY OF MARCH, 1964, IN THE VILLAGE OFFICE AT 2:00 PM.

The Court of Revision heard the following complaints:

1. Matt Hagel, Lot 28, Blk 1, Plan 4011X- Assessed too high.
2. Felix Hagel & Son- Lot 26, 27, Blk. 1, Plan 4011X--  
Assessed too high.
3. E. M. Hagel-Lot 10, Blk R, Plan 1424 JK - No kitchen  
cupboards, no trim.

After hearing the first two complaints, Mayor L. Schmaltz stated that the assessor had advised the Council that new rates had just been issued, and property classed as 17E3 on Lot 28, Blk. 1, Plan 4011X would be rated as 47.9 instead of 49.6.

Referring to Lots 26, 27, Blk. 1 Plan 4011X, the new rates would be 35.9 instead of 39.4 issued under class 17E3.

After hearing complaint number three, Mayor L. Schmaltz reported that the assessor had examined this property and had recommended that the valuation be changed from \$7,830 to \$7,680 on this property because of the complaint lodged.


