

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEISEKER, HELD ON MONDAY, THE EIGHTH DAY OF JUNE, A.D. 1964, IN THE VILLAGE OFFICE AT 8 P.M.

Present:

Mayor L. L. Schmaltz
Councillor F. Schmaltz

Minutes:

The minutes of the regular meeting, held on May 11, 1964 and the minutes of a special meeting held on April 8, 1964 were read by the Sec. Treas. and upon the motion of Counc. F. Schmaltz were adopted as read. The Mayor and Sec. Treas. then signed these minutes.

CARRIED.

Cash Statement :

The Sec. Treas. then read the cash statement for the month of May, 1964.

Counc. F. Schmaltz moved the adoption of this statement be accepted subject to the year end audit.

CARRIED.

Out of minutes;

Counc. F. Schmaltz reported he had contacted Mr. G. L. Rau for Weed Inspector for the Village and he was willing to accept this position. After some discussion, Mr. G. L. Rau was appointed by resolution, Weed Inspector for the Village, commencing his duties immediately for a period of six months at a remuneration of twenty dollars (\$20.00).

The Sec. Treas. was instructed to inform Mr. Rau of this appointment and have him sign the necessary forms to be forwarded to the Dep't of Agriculture.

New Business:

Mr. D. Olorenshaw (representative from Western Animal Care) and the Council discussed the agreement between Western Animal Care and the Village of Beiseker for the control of dogs, within the Village limits.

Upon the motion of Counc. F. Schmaltz, the Mayor and Sec. Treas. signed this agreement with Western Animal Care.

CARRIED.

By-Law No. 161

The Sec. Treas. then introduced a new By-Law on the control and harbouring of dogs within the Village limits. This By-Law was to revoke By-Law No. 18 (clause 4(11)) No. 147 and No. 156, and the new By-Law would be numbered 161, when finally passed.

Mayor L. L. Schmaltz moved it be given first reading.

CARRIED.

Counc. F. Schmaltz moved it be given second reading.

CARRIED.

Council discussed the matter of the Dep't of Highways using the new Village office for Drivers Examiners tests in the near future. The Sec. Treas. was asked to write to this Dep't asking if any remuneration could be received for this.

Enumerator:

In accordance with Sec. 112 of the Town and Village Act, the Council agreed to appoint Mrs. K. Wald as enumerator for the Village for the year 1964. The Sec. Treas. was instructed to advise Mrs. Wald of this appointment.

Bank Loan:

Upon receipt of current taxes ^{received} during the month of May 1964, Council instructed the Sec. Treas. to pay loans in the amount of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.00) at Royal Bank of Canada, Beiseker Branch.

New office:

Council discussed and agreed to accept the (\$678.00) six hundred and seventy-eight dollars quotation for installation of walls and ceilings at new office.
