3. Royal Bank of Canada, Lots 24-25, Block 2, Plan 4011X, assessed too high.

After hearing the first complaint, the Court decided the assessment would remain the same.

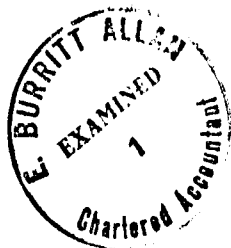
Regarding complaint number 2, the Court agreed to reserve decision on the appeal and consider the possibilities of getting a reduction on the grounds of Obsolescence Business.

After hearing complaint number three from the Royal Bank of Canada, Mr. Spence Assessor pointed out that the vaults had been valued too high and some of the measurements were not accurate.,

Mayor L.L. Schmaltz moved the acceptance of Mr. Spence that the assessment of this property be revised and reduced. moved by Councillor Felix Schmaltz..The landvalue will be the same, \$400.00, the building to be reduced to \$4580.00, a total of \$4980.00 Carried,
