

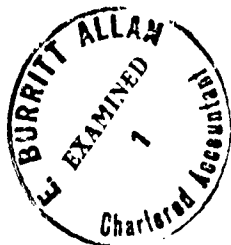
The purpose of the meeting was to decide on a suitable building site for the proposed Medical Clinic.

J.H. Schmaltz, Chairman of the Board, said that Dr. E. Verbeek had agreed to pay 150.00 dollars a month rent to the Co-Op for the use of the Clinic. Any Grants from the Village to be turned over to the Co-op.

Lots 2 and 3 were mentioned as a building site. Mayor L.L. Schmaltz suggested that these lots were not suitable, they were too small, they were on too busy a street and he did not think the Calgary Regional Planning Committee would approve.

Clarence Metzger moved that arrangements be made to negotiate for Lot 5, Block 9, Plan 1192FR.

It was moved that the Co-op proceed to negotiate with Metal Building Supplies, Mayor L.L. Schmaltz to act as an Advisory Member on the Committee appointed to contact Metal Building Supplies.
