The Council agreed to take over Sanitation of the Village as soon as possible.



The Council asked them if they would be willing to carry on with collecting the garbage for one month or untill such time as they were eqmipped to handle the job. They would reimburse them for the Insurance due on the Tractor and Trailer, fifteen dollars, and the License due, eleven dollars on the tractor and five dollars on the trailer., plus the regular fees.
