

THE MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL
THE VILLAGE OF BEISEKER HELD MAY 20, 1967.

New Business;

The Council met to review and approve the 1967 estimate, Councillor Felix Schmaltz moved that the proposed budget be adopted.

A By-Law No. 6-32 authorizing the several rates of taxation and setting the mill rate at 68 mills for 1967 was given, first, second and third reading and passed.

The Sec. Treas. was instructed to proceed with the mailing of the 1967 tax notices.

A letter of resignation was received by S. Reddekopp effective June 30th. By-Law # 4-2 was passed, confirming Mrs Patricia Tetz as Sec. Treas. for the Village of Beiseker, duties to commence July 1st, Salary subject to discussion.

Sec. Treas. was asked to contact Burritt Allan, Auditor to make a semi-annual audit in June.

The Council agreed that Water increase for June, July August and September be in effect and notices to that effect be included in the Notification of Provincial Grant forms.

Policing of the Village by R.C.M.P. was discussed. A motion was made by Councillor Adam Velker that the Village accept the proposed policing of the Village by the R.C.M.P. as of October 1, 1967.

Council agreed that the Home Owners Tax Rebate be dealt with as in 1966, full amount to be paid, and discount to be refunded after application has been approved by the Department.

Councillor Felix Schmaltz moved that Mayor L.L. Schmaltz purchase a Canadian flag and a Centennial flag for the Village to be flown in front of the Village Office.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned by Mayor L.L. Schmaltz.
