

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEISEKER HELD ON October 13th, 1967.

A special meeting of the council of the Village of Beiseker was called to pass bills and discuss gravelling Streets.

The oiling of streets was discussed, and as some residents have asked permission to oil streets surrounding their residences at their own expense, the council decided this permission be granted with the understanding that the streets must be bladed when needed.

The council discussed purchasing gravel from the C.N.R. for streets and also the alley behind Purity Service to Medical Clinic. The council decided to purchase gravel to the value of between \$500.00 to \$600.00 at 60¢ per yard at the pit, plus hauling.
