The Court of Revision heard the following complaints;


1. Miss Eva Wegener & Mrs L. Lount, Lot 32, Block 1,

After hearing complaint No. 1. the assessor advised the hearing that seeing the building is not rented at the present time and is not classed as a revenue that the taxes could be lowered for Obsolescence reasons, and would remain so until the building was again rented. Mayor Schmaltz informed Miss Wegener that the council would study this further and inform Miss Wegener of their decision, Miss Wegener excused herself from the hearing at this time, and it was discussed further with the Assessor and so decided give Miss Wegener and Mrs L. Lount completed 25 % Obsolescence reduction at this time and for the Secretary-Treasurer to contact them of their decision.

The second complaint of Mrs Silbernagel was discussed and reviewed and compared to other dwellings in the Village and the decision of the Court was that the taxes remain the same at this time, and the Secretary-Treasurer to contact Mrs Silbernagel of their decision as she was not present at the Court.

Their being no further complaints to be heard, Mayor Schmaltz adjourned the Court.

COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEISEKER HELD MARCH 11th, 1968

Minutes;

The minutes of the regular monthly meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker held February 13th, 1968 were read and adopted as correct by Councillor Adam Velker.

Financial Statement;

The financial statement for the month ending February 29th 1968 was read and adopted as correct by Councillor A. Velker subject to year end audit.

Old Business;

Mayor Schmaltz reported that two of the four residents who were sent letters under Registered mail, about their arrears in their water and sewer accounts had contacted him and made arrangements for their accounts in payments and agreements between them and the Village were to be drawn up by the Secretary-Treasurer for them to sign, and also that the other two residents had failed to contact them and that their services would be disconnected on March 12th, 1968.

Councillor Velker reported that the hot water heater at the Beiseker Hall was not working and Mr Velker was given the authority to remove the heater and send it to Wetaskawin to be repaired.

Mayor Schmaltz stated that the Recreation Committee of the Village had requested that the Village send a letter to the Department of Youth requesting that a recreation survey be done in our district as they are interested in erecting an arena in this area.

New Business;

It was moved by Councillor Adam Velker had E. B. Allan be appointed as Auditor for the Village of Beiseker for the year 1968. Seconded by Mayor L.L.Schmaltz. Carried.

The Secretary-Treasurer to advise Mr Allan of the appointment.

The purchase of a fire truck was discussed by Council and Mayor Schmaltz stated that the City of Calgary had two trucks for sale, and that perhaps the Council should drive to Calgary and see these engines. Also the purchase of a small tractor for the village was discussed and this should be seen to in the near future.

The agreement between the Village of Beiseker and the Department of Highways re- Dust-Proofing was reviewed by Council and Mayor Schmaltz suggested that he contact our engineers Reid Crowther & Partners to review this with him before the Agreement be signed.
