

THE MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF BEISEKER, HELD ON SUNDAY THE 29th DAY OF APRIL,
IN THE VILLAGE OFFICE, AT 8:11 P.M.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the severe shortage of water in the village water system.

All those present inspected the resevoir and the village well and then returned to the office for discussion.

The council agreed to ration the water until further notice as follows;

The water will be on ebery hour on the hour for ten minutes, from 7 A.M. to 11 P.M.

The water will be off from 11 P.M. to 7 A.M.


Councillor Lavoie offered to mimeograph copies of this notice for mailing to the village water subscribers.

The subject of the frozen sewer main in front of Mrs. Fishers residence was brought up. Town Foreman Mr. Krenzler stated that the sewer cleaning tape belonging to the Village was not heavy enough for the job. It was decided to try and obtain something heavier.

Some discussion followed on the Village estimate for 1956. The Sec-Treas. was asked to have the estimate completed and a By-Law prepared setting the mill rate and authorizing the collection of taxes for the next regular meeting.

There being no further business to discuss at this time the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Councillor Velker.
