

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF BEISEKER, HELD JULY 16, 1968.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Schmaltz who in turn explained that the meeting was called to discuss the Dust-Proofing program with Mr. Vickerman. Mayor Schmaltz then turned the meeting over to Mr. Vickerman, who explained and read a report and survey that he himself had made in Saskatchewan. The program that he suggested to be tried in our Village is being used extensively and satisfactorily in the Province. He explained that he had travelled on different stretches of roads and talked with Road Foreman and Engineers and was quite confident that this would be suitable to use in our Village. Mr. Vickerman suggested that the Council do a test stretch of road in our Village possibly the Crescent and two blocks of main street plus the two blocks north past the school. Mayor Schmaltz made a motion that the Village authorize Mr. Vickerman to discuss our plan with Border Paving Limited, Red Deer, to see what this project would cost and whether they would be able to do the job. Carried.

Mr. Vickerman stated that he would be meeting with Border Paving on Monday July 22, on other business and at that time would discuss our needs and requirements with them. Mr. Vickerman stated he would in turn contact Mayor Schmaltz of the results.

There being no further business to discuss Mayor Schmaltz adjourned the meeting.
