

THE MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING HELD IN THE COUNCIL
CHAMBERS April 15, 1969.

The hearing was opened by Mayor Schmaltz and the Beiseker Plan 1968 was discussed by Mr. Marriott and the Council. The Council felt that more area should be designated for Commercial properties. The plan was studied very fully and three more small locations were changed for this purpose.

The rest of the plan was covered fully by Council and no further changes were planned. Mr. Marriott would take the plans back to the Calgary Regional planning Commission for their final processes, as there was no objections to the plan by other citizens of the Village.

The Council and Mr. Marriott then studied the Preliminary Plan for Zoning that would be covered very fully at a meeting in Calgary April 30, 1969. This was discussed and studied very fully by Council.

There being no further business to discuss Mayor Schmaltz adjourned the hearing.
