

THE MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEISEKER HELD SEPTEMBER 27, 1969 IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS.

Mayor Schmaltz explained to the Council the reason for the Special meeting to meet with Mr. Alex Goodman to discuss the sale of the Trailer Court.

Mr. Goodman expressed to the Council that he wished to purchase the trailer court and would like to take over the 1st of October if they excepted his offer. This was discussed in full by the Council and decided to except Mr. Goodman's offer of a cheque for \$2,000.00 and two 50' lots. These being Lots 19 and 20 in Block 13, Plan 1192 F.R.

The Secretary-Treasurer instructed to send a letter to each of the trailer owners stating that the Court had been sold and that for the next 60 days at least the trailer rent would remain the same. Also that \$5.00 per month was still payable to the Village for Mobile License and \$16.00 rent including water and sewer payable to Mr. Goodman.

Transfer costs of both titles would be split between the Village and Mr. Goodman.

Mr. Goodman explained that there was a building on these two Lots being transferred to the Village and this building must be removed by spring of 1970.

A letter was read to Council that was received from Mr. Dave Lang offering to buy the Trailer Court and was discussed and ordered filed, as Mr. Goodman was chosen to be the purchaser.

There being no further business to discuss Mayor Schmaltz adjourned the meeting.
