
Mayor Schmaltz opened the meeting and explained to Council the New area study of the Calgary Area that he has worked on and explained the new Highways and entrances to the City of Calgary that are being planned for the future.

A motion by Councillor Velker that the Village of Feischer accept the offer of Mr. Henry Zisk/Rohl of Calgary's offer to purchase the Church property for the sum of \$2200.00. An agreement was drawn up by the Village for both parties to sign, Mr. Rohl wishes to build 22 - 4 unit Apartment Buildings on this property and also applied for a building permit, which was discussed by Council and on a motion by Councillor Velker was passed.


Mayor Schmaltz also reported to the meeting that he had received a letter from the Government of the Province of Alberta allowing the Village a further \$3000.00 Contingency grant for work on the North Road, the grant to be sent directly to the Municipal District of Rockyview whose crew will be doing the work on the North road in conjunction with their work on the west road.

Mayor Schmaltz stated that he had a letter from the Village Engineers and that four bids had been received for the Drainage and road work within the Village. These bids were studied in full by Council and also a letter was read from the Engineers Reid Crowther & Partners with reference to the bids with full explanation of each. Councillor Velker Made a motion to accept Marcinek Construction of Red Deer's bid. This bid being the lowest and with better equipment and would also be ready to move in to commence work within ten day to two weeks. Carried.

There being no further business to discuss Mayor Schmaltz adjourned the meeting.
