

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF REISER WILD SEPTEMBER 14, 1970 IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS.

MINUTES:

The minutes of the regular monthly meeting held August 10th were read and adopted as correct by Councillor Velker.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT:

The Financial Statement for the month of August was read and adopted as correct by Councillor Schmaltz subject to year end audit.

BUSINESS:

Mayor Schmaltz explained to Council that the \$15,000.00 term deposit invested at the Royal Bank collected \$36.25 interest in one month and Council advised Secretary-Treasurer to inform the Bank that they wish to reinvest for another 30 days.

Mayor Schmaltz reported that Marcinek Construction was at present in the Village doing the Drainage work and that some changes were made with Mr. Marcinek in that the Village would gravel the road with Marcinek Construction to compact the surface and do the piling and that the Village use their grader and charge Mr. Marcinek accordingly. Mayor Schmaltz suggested to Council that the gravel be purchased from E. McMair, at a price to be agreed upon by both parties and that the gravel that the Village have stockpiled be kept for future use.

The work on the North Road was discussed by Council and Mayor Schmaltz reported that the Municipality suggested 4" of base and 2" of asphalt for the North Road with the M.D. hauling the gravel. The dump yard was discussed by Council and Councillor Schmaltz moved that Marcinek Construction be hired to clean up the dump yard on an hourly basis. Carried;

Councillor Velker stated that Rightways Painters of Calgary were hired to do the Painting in the interior upstairs of the Hall and were in the Village ready to start working immediately.

The delegation attending the meeting from the Recreation Board with Mr. Cerald Schissel as spokesman and stated that some work should be done at the Friendship park and listed their suggestions, the ball field, repairs to fence, Bleacher repairs and extensions, and storage in the Centennial Building. The ball field area was discussed first and it was agreed that some clay should be hauled on the diamond and possibly by Marcinek Construction and the M.D. equipment was in the immediate area this could possibly be arranged. The storage area in the Centennial building is available and that some shelves would have to be installed. The Council agreed that possibly some better snow fencing could be installed around the diamond and the Village could possibly hold financially with this endeavor with possibly some help from the Lion's Club. The bleacher extensions could possibly be built during the winter months with volunteer labor to do the work. The Council agreed to supply the paint to repaint the existing bleachers with the labor to be donated. The delegation than thanked Council for listening to their suggestions and also for the Village's assistance in completing some of these suggestions in the future and excused themselves from the meeting.

The water and sewer extensions were discussed by Council and was decided that the extension to the court would not be made at this time as Mr. Goodman does not require it, but the sewer extension to Mr. Fernandez would be completed as soon as the drainage work was completed.


