

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEISEHER HELD NOVEMBER 9, 1970 IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS.

MINUTES:

The minutes of the first statutory meeting of the Village of Beiseher were read and adopted as correct by Councillor Schwaltz.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT:

The Financial statement for the month of October 1970 was read and adopted as correct by Councillor A. Volker subject to year end audit.

BUSINESS:

Mayor Schwaltz opened the meeting by welcoming Cpl Shepherd to the meeting and told Cpl Shepherd to proceed with his comments that he wished to make. Cpl Shepherd opened with remarks of congratulations to the Council on their good procedure of opening their meetings, and then proceeded to explain to the Council the reasons for his attendance. Cpl Shepherd he wished to ~~have~~ have the feeling of the Council on whether they were satisfied with the way they were policing the Village and in what way they could do more in covering some of the By-Laws, such as children with bicycles on the sidewalks etc, and perhaps the best way to control this in a better fashion would be to educate the parents on the rules through the school and Home & School organization. Cpl Shepherd also explained the By-Law that the Village could pass under the Highway Traffic act covering Village rules and regulations and tickets could be printed and given to the R.C.M.P. to hand out when this infractions were broken. The Secretary-Treasurer was thus instructed to order copies of Highway Act from the Queen's Printer. Cpl Shepherd also stated that he is in full agreement that a curfew should be enforced in the Village at perhaps the age being 15 years and under off the streets by 9 O'clock. This was discussed in full with Council and all the other policing rules and the Council than gave Cpl Shepherd their views in that they were completely pleased in the way things were handled police wise in the Village and assured him that he had the complete backing of the Council in his endeavors. Cpl Shepherd than excused himself from the meeting and thanked them very much for their time.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Schwaltz reported to Council that the new sewer line to Mr. Fernandez was completed and the Secretary-Treasurer instructed to comply the complete cost of installation. ~~///~~
Council Schwaltz reported that Joe Hagel had agreed to blow the siren at Noon hour but as yet Bill Eitzen, electrician had not moved the switch to Hagel's Hardware.




