


The Special meeting was opened by Mayor Schwalz who explained the reason for the meeting was to meet with M. Fenerty Planner for the Calgary Regional Planning Commission to cover the most important parts of the Zoning and General Plan for the area and covered the details in full as to the parts that are most important to the Village. Mr. Fenerty explained the the proposed way of planning the areas in the Low and High Density areas and a complete review of the Village areas on a map and how each area should be classed as High or Low density areas as they will be shown in the preliminary plan that will be sent out as soon as possible and some changes could be made at that time before the final drafting of this plan. The plan was discussed in full by Mr. Fenerty and Council and questions by the Council were answered very capably by Mr. Fenerty. He than excused himself from the meeting.
