
BY-LAW #31A


The Library By-law that the Council passed was discussed and a letter was read that was received from the Department of Culture, Youth and Recreation stating that the By-law was passed under the Municipal Act rather than the Libraries Act. On a motion by Councillor to move that By-Law 31 be rescinded and a new By-Law #31A be passed. The new By-Law #31A was given first, second and third reading and finally passed, seconded by Councillor Hagem. Carried. Mr. Archer, Chairman of the new Library Board to receive a copy of the new By-Law and a letter of explanation.

The S.T.E.P. was discussed and reviewed by Council and the application was completed applying for 2 Male students, 1 female student and 1 Supervisor. The application to be sent in by the Secretary-Treasurer.
