


THE MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF  
THE VILLAGE OF BEISEKER HELD AUGUST 22nd at 7;30 P.M. IN THE  
COUNCIL CHAMBERS.

Mayor Schmaltz opened the meeting and introduced Mr. Johnson to Council and asked Mr. Johnson to proceed with his comments. Mr. Johnson explained to the Council his proposals and covered each proposal thoroughly. He explained that the Council through their Health Unit try and set up a Medical Centre in the Medical Building in which there would be a Municipal Nurse their during office hours, these nurses are well capable in looking after the small needs such as stitching small cuts and attending to small emergencies, and perhaps than having a Doctor coming a few days a week. Mr. Johnson also suggested that the Village could contact Doctor Willstoncroft, Head of the College of Medical Doctors for his assistance in locating a Doctor. He also suggested that perhaps Mayor Schmaltz, who is on the Board of the Hospitals, Rockyview and Holy Cross, could discuss this matter with Doctor Maynes, who is Chief of Staff at the Holy Cross for his assistance. These proposals were discussed at some length by Mr. Johnson and the Council.

The Medical Building was than discussed, and Mayor Schmaltz than suggested that perhaps Mr. Johnson would like to see the facilities that we have available for Doctors. Mayor Schmaltz than adjourned the meeting, and Council and Mr. Johnson left to view the building.
