THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEISEKER HELD MARCH 12, 1973 IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT 7:30 P.M.

MINUTES:

As the minutes of the previous meeting were circulated Councillor Hagel moved their adoption, seconded by Councillor Schmaltz.  
CARRIED.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT:

The financial statement for the month of February was read and adopted as correct by Councillor Schmaltz, subject to year end audit. Seconded by Councillor Hagel.  
CARRIED.

BUSINESS from MINUTES:

Mayor Schmaltz reported to Council that an ad had not been placed for bids on the Village machine and backhoe work that perhaps it would be better to wait until a study of the work to be done by the Village in 1973, as this could have a definite bearing on the bids that would be received.

The new mobile home lots were discussed again by Council and work is being done, on the Zoning By-Law, so that if anyone inquires about a lot in this area they can be told that lots will be available in the spring. C.R.P.C

NEW BUSINESS:

Councillor Schmaltz reported that the Electrical Inspector was here in the Village and also with electrician Bill Eitzen a study was made of the Lift Station, the Inspector would contact the W.C.B. and than in turn contact the Village re work to be done. Councillor Schmaltz instructed that he was to get a full price of the work to be done from Mr. Eitzen.

Secretary reported to council that A.G.T. would be purchasing Lot 13, Blk 9, 1192 F.R. and also Mrs V. Hagel had made a deposit on Lot 12, Blk 9, 1192 FR. (OPTION)

The property of Mrs Mabel Huether (North half of block 7) was discussed by Council at some length and Councillor Hagel to contact Mrs Heuther to see if she would be interested in selling this property to the Village. The village owned property was discussed in full by Council and was decided that some planning should be done for future development.

-BY-LAW 8-15

A resolution was made by Councillor Schmaltz, seconded by Councillor Hagel to borrow up to \$8000.00 from the Royal Bank in Beiseker to cover operating expenses until tax money comes in for 1973. By-Law # 8-15 given first, second and third reading and finally passed.  
CARRIED.

The minutes and financial statement from the Library board were studied by Council and Council to accept the recommendation of the board that Myrna Richards be appointed as a member to replace Mr. Archer who had resigned, also the recommendation of the board that Mr. Haxton replace Mr. Whittaker who also resigned. MOVED BY COUNCILLOR SCHMALTZ TO ACCEPT THESE RECOMMENDATIONS OF MRS RICHARDS & MR HAXTON.

There being no further business to discuss Mayor Schmaltz adjourned the meeting.
