BUSINESS:

Mayor Schmaltz explained to council that the meeting was called to finalize the budget for 1975. The Secretary than in turn explained the budget step by step to the Council as this year new budget forms were being used, and recommended to Council that the Mill Rate would have to be increased to 95 Mills to offset the increase in every department. The increase of 5 Mills would be required for Calgary School Requisition alone as there was a large increase in their requisition. This was discussed by Council at some length

BY_LAW 75-1

It was moved by Councillor Whitnack to pass By-Law 75-1 for the Village of Beiseker to set the mill rate for 1975 at 95 Mills. Seconded by Mayor Schmaltz.

It was moved by Councillor Whitnack to give final reading to By-Law 75-1 to set the Mill rate for 1975 at 95 Mills. Seconded by Mayor Schmaltz.
CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Secretary was than instructed by Council to proceed with preparing the tax notices to be mailed as soon as possible.

The Secretary than advised Council that she had received a Ministerial Order from Department of Municipal Affairs to use the 1974 Assessment Roll for 1975. The Assessor's were unable to do the Annual Assessment this^{↑YEAR} but it would be done in 1975 for 1976.
